Centre for Justice & Change - \$30,000

- Promoting Human Rights in Eastern Sri Lanka for transitional justice
- Supporting Community Leaders in Trincomalee & Batticaloa

International Working Group on Sri Lanka Ltd - \$14,460

- Supporting human rights, justice, reform & reconciliation via civil society to mobilize domestic & international support to promote democratic values

Freedom of Expression - \$100,000

- Promoting democratic governance
- Independent journalism – media network publishing political articles, videos etc

Centre for Human Rights & Development - \$70,000

- Legal assistance for those detained under PTA
- Repealing PTA & other policies that infringe civil liberties & human rights

Janawaboda Kendraya - \$41,500

- Enable citizens to be more engaged in political process at local level
- Volunteers in 10 districts giving "leadership" "community" training on democracy
- Street theatre to encourage engagement between citizens & govt officials

Law & Society Trust - \$50,000
